

Shipping and Receiving Overview

Ships via Freight Truck to a terminal or a business location with forklift, loading dock or for terminal pick up. Due to the large pallet size (86"L x 68"W x 63"H), a forklift or a loading dock is usually necessary to off load from the truck. A liftgate is technically not wide enough to support the pallet.

Ships factory assembled with wheels, and tongue removed for transit efficiency.
Allow approximately 30 minutes to complete, hitch up and go!

Tools Needed:

1. Cordless drill with a Phillips head chuck recommended (for slat crate removal)
2. 13/16" Wrench (for Tires)
3. Extra set of hands to lift on side, or car Jack for mounting tires (may be placed anywhere underneath trailer)
4. 5/8" Wrench & Socket (for Tongue)
